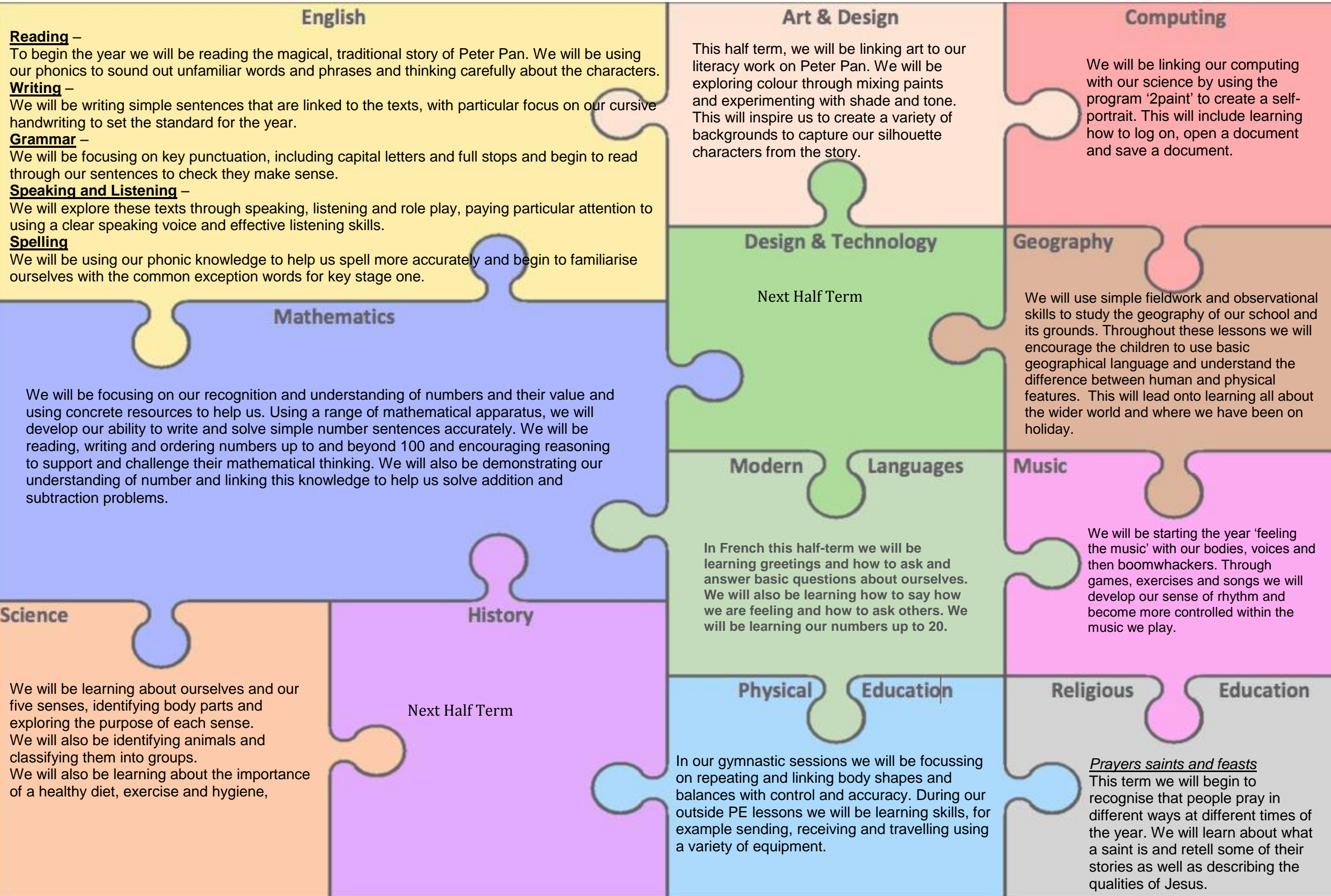


St. Swithun's: Year 1/2 Curriculum Map – Autumn 1. Topic: New Adventures
