- Velcro letter labelling jobs
- Writing CVC words eg cat, dog, pin, hat...
- Continuing with RWI phonics (see your child's Teams account for more information)
- Writing for different purposes (tickets, boarding pass, licences)

Mathematics

- Counting with 1:1 correspondence
- Number formation
- Link number symbol to number value
- Explore arrangements of numbers (knowing that the same number is represented in different ways)
- Exploring ways of representing numbers
- Matching numerals to grouped/arrangement of objects
- Shape transport
- Adding 1 more and 1 less

Understanding of the World

- Looking at old and new types of transport
- Using Beebots as a method of transport (around a map)
- Using the Beebot programe on the ipad
- Looking at maps
- Where do we live?

Expressive Arts and Design

- Explore and use a variety of artistic effects
- Develop storylines in play
- Negotiating and sharing ideas
- Making rockets
- Firework painting using sugar water and pipettes
- Using collage materials to create pictures
- Joining and fixing materials
- Junk modelling vehicles
- Printing with paint
