St. Swithun's: Year 1/2 Curriculum Map – Summer 1. Topic:

Major outcomes for the topic: Writing our own version of The Tear Thief in English

English

As part of our English work this half term, we will be reading the book The Tear Thief by Carol Ann Duffy. We will build our comprehension skills by answering questions using the text to support our answers. Some of us will begin to make links with other similar stories.

We will then be applying everything we have learnt in writing so far to use exciting vocabulary to write our own story based on The Tear Thief. Year 1 children will be using their phonics to help them choose the correct grapheme when spelling words as well as applying simple suffixes such as -ed and -ing to verbs. Year 2 children will be ensuring they use a range of conjunctions to extend their sentences as well as using words with more complex suffixes such as -ful, -less, -ness and -ment.

Handwriting will continue to be a focus for all.

Mathematics

In Maths, we will be reviewing our place value skills and continue to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will then introduce fractions and learn how to find ½ of shapes and amounts and ¼ of shapes and amounts. We will explore this in a range of different ways, including in real life contexts. Year 2s will then learn how to find two quarters and three quarters of shapes and amounts. To finish the half term, we will explore length and height and have different opportunities to measure different objects and make comparisons. Year 1 will measure objects using a non-standard measure such as cubes and year 2 will measure objects in centimetres and metres. At home, children can practise their maths skills by playing adding and subtract games, using Hit the Button online to practise recall of number bonds and regularly playing Numbots.

Science

We will be learning about how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will explore what plants need to germinate and stay healthy by setting up tests to compare their growth under different conditions. We will closely observe plants in our local environment and record our findings. As part of our learning, we will study the life cycle of plants and how we can tell they are living things. We will also compare how different plants grow and observe any

We will start be looking at Holy Week focussing on Palm Sunday and the Last Supper. We will be looking at Easter, concentrating on the resurrection of Jesus. We will look at the impact it had on the people who witnessed it.
