<p>Australia</p> 	<p>English Writing This half term we will be learning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To retell the story through actions, role play and sequencing pictures. Year 1 children will retell the story and year 2 children will be writing their own story based on the book by changing details such as the main character and the planet he lands on. To spell common exception words correctly in their work and they should be using our phonics knowledge to spell words. 	<p>English Grammar This half term includes...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensuring our sentences make sense Using conjunctions such as 'and', 'because', 'so', 'but', 'when' and 'that' to extend sentences. Consistent use of capital letters and full stops at the end as well as exclamation and question marks. Re-reading our writing, to check punctuation and spellings are correct.
<p>Maths This term our core learning focuses on...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Length and Height – measuring different objects using non-standard units of measure such as multilink and our hands. Year 2 will measure objects in CM and M. We will use our place value knowledge and compare and order lengths. Capacity – measuring liquids using the terms full, half full, empty. Year 2 will measure volumes using ML and L. We will compare the capacity of different containers Time- we will use an analogue clock to tell the time to o' clock and half past. Year 2 will learn to tell the time to quarter past and quarter to. 	<p>RE This half term we will be learning about</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Easter story Recognising key figures Retelling the main parts through writing, art and role play.
