


KS1 Summer 2 overview

<p>Great Explorers</p> 	<p>English Writing</p> <p>This half term we will be learning about</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Diary writing and 1st person <p>Handwriting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • always writing on the line • forming our letters correctly • making sure capital letters are clear and slightly larger than our lower-case letters 	<p>English Grammar</p> <p>This half term includes...</p> <p>Year 1:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • recapping writing simple sentences • joining sentences using 'and.' • simple suffixes such as 'ed' and 'ing' to words. <p>Year 2:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • using a range of different conjunctions such as 'and', 'because', 'so', 'but', 'when' and 'that.' • possessive apostrophes • commas in a list • recapping question marks, exclamation marks and apostrophes for contractions.
<p>Maths</p> <p>This term our core learning focuses on...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • recapping and building on our knowledge of place value within 100 • solving problems and explaining our reasoning about numbers. • mental strategies to solve addition and subtraction calculations which will include applying our number bond knowledge. • data handling by sorting ourselves into groups based on eye colour, shoe size etc • recording data into a table. • presenting data in pictograms and bar graphs. • Consolidating written methods for all four operations and applying these to a variety of reasoning and problem-solving problems. • Year 1 will recap telling the time to o' clock and half past and year 2 will begin to tell the time in 5-minute intervals. 	<p>RE</p> <p>This half term we will</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • explore the story of Pentecost • understand that this is the birthday of the Church. • learn that Jesus promised to send his Spirit and at Pentecost we see that he kept his promise. 	<p>Books we will read in addition to our RWI book bag books</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 'Diary of a Killer Cat' by Anne Fine • Little people, big dreams: Neil Armstrong • Claude in the City
